Tahoe Conduit Connection



TAHOE NEW CONDUIT CONNECTION

The base of the Tahoe enclosure has been modified for increased flexibility of electrical connections. There are still two 13mm (1/2inch) knockouts in the base, but an additional 22mm (7/8 inch) diameter knockout has been added to enable conduit fittings to be used when necessary.

The Tahoe will still come as standard with a cable and a cable gland in one of the 13mm knockouts, but there is now the flexibility to change the installation on site if necessary. This

22mm knockout also allows for an additional cable for a separate initial charge signal.

The knockouts are easy to remove. The easiest way to do this is to insert a screwdriver into the slot, pushing it through the plastic and then gently prying out the knockout. Take care not to apply too much sudden force as this may damage the base of the unit.

The drawing below shows the position of the relevant holes.
