PRODUCT DIRECTIONS

EQUIPMENT TO USE

Pail with wringer and mop or scrubbing machine and wet vacuum cleaner.

DIRECTIONS TO USE

Blockade areas to be stripped. Apply test solution in an out of the way spot of floor to assure product will not bleed or otherwise effect floor. If there is no effect, proceed as follows: 1. To remove metal complex finishes and most other polymer finishes - Prepare a 1:11 dilution of H.D. Stripper with hot or cold water (1 1/2 cups/gallon). For heavy build up and difficult-to-remove sealers, H.D. Stripper may be diluted 1:2 with hot or cold water (8 cups/gallon). 2. Apply solution at rate of 100 square feet per gallon. Apply enough material to insure complete wetting. 3. Allow to stand 3-5 minutes maximum. DO NOT ALLOW SOLUTION TO DRY. 4. For best results, wet vacuum residue. If not possible, mop for recovery. If mop is used for recovery, use extreme care to remove all of the product. 5. Though not necessary, machine scrubbing will speed work, especially when removing buildups. **NOTE:** Floors will become slippery when stripper is applied. Exercise caution.
