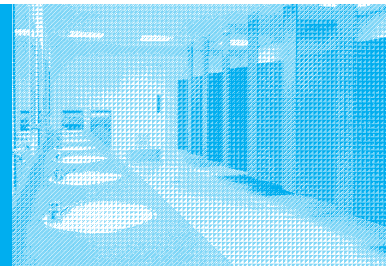

PRODUCT DIRECTIONS

EQUIPMENT TO USE

Sprayer or hose-end foamers and bowl mop.

DIRECTIONS TO USE

DAILY CLEANING: Dilute with up to 5 parts water. Rinse thoroughly after cleaning. On stainless steel equipment, dilute with up to 3 parts water. Rinse thoroughly after cleaning. Dilute with up to 5 parts water for tile and porcelain. Rinse and wipe with a damp cloth. **TOILETS:** To remove calcium and rust encrustations, discolorations and other deposits, flush toilet, then remove water from bowl by forcing it over trap with applicator. Holding bottle over bowl, start the cleaning under the rim where the water outlets are located. Then apply a small amount directly to applicator. Thoroughly clean top and other areas of the bowl. **URINALS:** Apply solution to applicator while holding it over urinal. Clean entire surface, especially under rim and at water outlets. Pour a small amount into urinal and let stand for several minutes to remove odors from trap. Do not use on aluminum.
