Directions For Use

Equipment: Pail and mop, sponge, cleaning cloth, spray bottle, appropriate measuring device, scrub brush, rubber gloves and eye protection.

Use Dilution: 1:64 2 OUNCES PER GALLON OF WATER (660 ppm quat) This product is not for use on medical device surfaces.

DISINFECTION/CLEANING/DEODORIZING DIRECTIONS:

Remove heavy soil deposits from surface, then thoroughly wet surface with a use-solution of 2 ounces per gallon of water. The use-solution can be applied with a cloth, mop, sponge, or coarse spray or by soaking. For sprayer applications, use a coarse spray device. Spray 6-8 inches from the surface, rub with a brush, cloth or sponge. Do not breathe spray. Let solution remain on surface for a minimum of 10 minutes. Rinse or allow to air dry.
