Directions For Use

Equipment: Mop and pail, sponge, cleaning cloths, appropriate measuring devices. Wear eye protection and rubber gloves when mixing product.

Light Duty Cleaning: For painted walls, woodwork, other painted wood surfaces and touch-up cleaning. 1. Mix 1/3 cup of this product with 2-1/2 gallons of water. 2. Rinse well with water after cleaning.

Moderate Duty Cleaning: For the removal of wax buildup and ground-in surface dirt on linoleum, vinyl, ceramic tile, asphalt and rubber tile floors. 1. Mix 1/2 cup of this product with 2-1/2 gallons of water. Mop area to be cleaned. 2. Rinse well with water after cleaning.

Heavy Duty Cleaning: For brick, terrazzo and concrete floors.

1. Wet surface to be cleaned. 2. Sprinkle dry product over heavily soiled areas and scrub with a stiff bristle broom or brush to loosen soil before mopping. 3. Rinse well with water. 4. Mix 2/3 cup of this product with 2-1/2 gallons of water. Mop area to be cleaned. 5. Rinse well with water after cleaning.

NOTE: This product may damage some paints. Clean a small area before cleaning the entire surface. Do not use on glass.
