Directions For Use

Equipment: Recommended automatic liquid laundry or warewash injection system.

Use Dilution: Concentration varies due to environmental conditions. Your sanitation specialist will properly adjust product concentration to meet your needs.

For High Temperature Warewashing:

- 1. Pre-flush and/or scrape dishes before washing.
- 2. Rack dishes properly. Place dishes in machine.
- 3. Wash using this product and a recommended warewashing detergent. Maintain wash temperature at 150°-160°F.
- 4. For rinse cycle, use a recommended rinse additive. Maintain rinse temperature at 180°-190°F.
- 5. Allow dishes to air drv.

For Laundry:

- 1. Pre-sort laundry prior to wash.
- 2. Pre-soak and/or pre-spot laundry when necessary.
- 3. Place proper amount of soiled fabric into laundry machine.
- In wash cycle, feed this product and a recommended liquid laundry detergent.
- 5. When bleaching, feed a recommended liquid laundry destainer.
- When souring and/or softening, feed a recommended liquid sour and/or softener. A final pH of 5.5-6.5 is recommended for the fabric.
- *This product can be used in all water temperatures. Your chemical specialist will adjust product concentrations based on results.
